- Using our cloud-based compliance system Donesafe to implement a pro-active risk management approach that identifies, manages, and/or eliminates safety risks associated with work activities
- Ensuring that all workplace hazards, accidents and incidents are reported into Donesafe immediately and accurately, which will result in the appropriate corrective action to be taken
- Providing relevant instruction, training and supervision to improve individual employee understanding and awareness of WHS procedures
- Ensuring that all employees, contractors and visitors comply with appropriate WHS standards and procedures set out by Waterlogic
- Provide adequate systems and resources to effectively manage WHS programs, workers compensation, rehabilitation and return to work processes.

Waterlogic has implemented and maintains ongoing WHS programs has designated WHS representatives at each worksite.

We encourage employees, contractors and visitors to take all reasonable care and responsibility for their own health and safety and the health and safety of others.
